Introduction. The modern art gallery Tate Modern in London is part of the Tate Gallery with the Tate Britain, Tate Liverpool and Tate St Ives, the latter two out of the capital. Project managers were the Swiss architects Jacques Herzog and Pierre de Meuron, winners of the Pritzker Prize in 2001. The gallery is located in the old Bankside Power Station, originally designed by Sir Giles Gilbert Scott and built in two phases between 1947 and 1963, the building fell into disuse after 1981.
